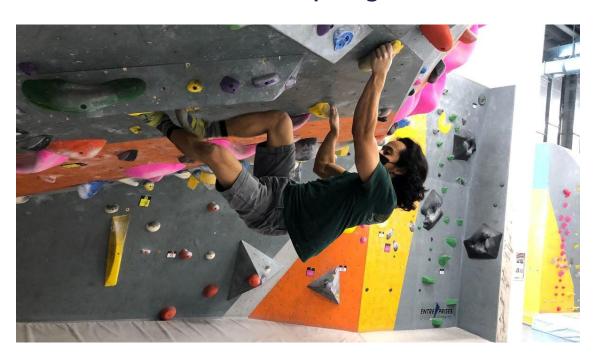

#### **Workshop Update**





We were recently blessed to have CYAK staffer Drew Williams stay with us for a week. During that time Drew lead a workshop on how to make cutting boards. After a few sessions both residents and staff members have made some really beautiful cutting boards and we now have another product to create and offer.

Caleb Szczepanski (recently hired CYAK operations manager) has also started opening the shop to residents on a weekly basis and has a host of skills to share.

Lastly, we have found new materials and suppliers to improve our crafting quality. This includes moving from sawblades to alloy sheet metal, locating bulk hardwood providers, and beginning to incorporate some animal materials such as antlers into our projects.

#### **House Study**

House study continues to offer both encouragement and challenges. We finished our study on Jonah which fostered a lot of good conversation around God's grace, compassion, and our human tendency to function in bias. Following Jonah we spent two weeks taking a

close look at love, covering things like biblical love vs worldly love, Greek and Hebrew root words, common misconceptions, and the utter necessity for us to function in love. We are now launching a six week series studying Psalm 23 in which we will be gradually unearthing the question, "do you trust the Lord to care for your needs?" During our first session looking at Psalm 23 we had some excellent conversation including EVERY present resident choosing to share things that have helped them process trauma and move past the point of feeling consumed or trapped by it.
